BOLTON AUTOTEST 14th JUNE 2009

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Bolton-le-Moors Car Club Ltd will organise a National 'B' and Clubsport Production Car Autotest on Sunday 14th June 2009 at the First Motorway Services – M61(between jnc 6 & 8), West Bound, Lancashire (Map Ref: 109/621117)
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organizing Club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit has been applied for and will be on display on the day.
4. The National B event is open to fully elected members of Bolton-le-Moors Car Club Ltd and registered contenders in the following championships of which the event is a round of:

2009 ANWCC Autotest, Novice Autotest & Allrounders Championship
2009 ANCC Autotest Championship
2009 SD34MSG Off Road Championship & SD34MSG Inter Club League
2009 AWMCC Autotest Championship
5. The Clubsport Production Car Autotest is open to all fully paid up members of:
Bolton-le-Moors Car Club, Accrington MSC, CSMA and Knutsford & DMC
All drivers must produce a valid club membership card, a competition licence is NOT required for the Clubsport event. Entries may be accepted from drivers between the ages of 14 to 16 at the date of the event, or over 17 without a RTA Licence, but they may only drive a 4 seat saloon type car upto 1600cc with no form of forced induction. The passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be a person experienced in Autotesting.

6. All competitors for the National B event must produce a valid MSA Competition Licence/ Championship Registration Card and/or a Club membership card. For the duration of the event all competitors will be deemed to be members of Bolton-le-Moors Car Club Ltd however a valid membership card for an MSA registered motor club must be produced by each competitor. Where appropriate, a valid Entrants Licence must also be produced for inspection.
7. The programme for the meeting will be, 8.30-10.00am Scrutineering & Signing on. Any competitor not signed on by 10.00am may be excluded. Driver's Briefing will be held at 10.15am. The first test will start at 10.30am and the last test is scheduled to finish approx 16.30hrs.
8. The National B event will consist of five classes, as follows:-
 - Class A – Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length
 - Class B – Saloon Cars over 11ft overall length
 - Class C – Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
 - Class D – Specials
 - Class E – Road Going Saloon Cars

All vehicles in Class E must be capable of being driven on the road, must be taxed with a valid MOT (if applicable), documents to be produced at Scrutineering.

'Saloons' will include estate cars, hatchbacks and commercial types as appropriate as well as saloon type Kit Cars. Cabriolet will run in the appropriate classes depending on whether the top is raised or lowered, which may not be changed during the competition. Overall length of the vehicle will include bumpers whether fitted or not.

All cars must comply with current MSA tyre and vehicle regulations.

9. Awards for the National B event will be presented as follows:

Fastest Time of Day	An Award
1 st in Class	An Award (Subject to 2 starters)
2 nd in Class	An Award (Subject to 6 starters)
3 rd in Class	An Award (Subject to 10 starters)
Best Lady Competitor	An Award (Subject to 2 starters)
Best Novice *	An Award (Subject to 2 starters)
Best BLMCC Member	An Award

* A novice is defined as a person who has not won a Novice / Class / Overall award on a National B status event or higher.

10. Awards for the Clubsport Production Car event will be

Fastest Time of Day	An Award
2 nd Overall	An Award

11. The entry list opens on the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on Sunday 14th June 2009. The entry fee at the discount rate for the event is £25.00 up to Sunday 7th June 2009 after which time the entry fee will be £30.00. All entries must be made on the official Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Entries will be seeded in the **reverse order** of receipt. All cheques/postal orders should be made payable to **Bolton-le-Moors Car Club Ltd.**

Entry fees may be refunded (less an administration charge) up to the closing date only if notice is given in writing, and thereafter at the discretion of the Organisers (C(a)-59(e)).

N.B. Entries will be accepted from Drivers without a current full RTA licence provided they comply with the requirements of D.30

13. The maximum entry for the event is 60 and the minimum is 25. There is no maximum per class but the minimum is 3. Should any of these figures not be reached the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.

15. Provisional results will be displayed throughout the day and will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Final results will be emailed out within 7 days of the event.
16. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C(d)47.
17. a. Details of tests will be given out at signing on.
b. Timing will be by handheld stop watches to 1/10 second
c. Each driver will have one run at each Test to count for the awards
d. The starting signal will be "in your own time"
e. Cars will start with the front wheels on the start line and timing will start as the front wheel crosses the timing line
18. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.
19. Marking and penalties will be as D Appendix 1. Table F1 except the following which are modified (d) 5 marks lost.
20. All general Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are amended:
D.13 Posts or pylons may be less than 1.0m high.
D.20 The definition of a test performance and wrong test is replaced as follows:
"In any diagram illustrating a test, dimensions will be approximate and for guidance only, whilst a sequence of manoeuvres will be mandatory but not exclusive. A maximum penalty will be imposed when the mandatory sequence of manoeuvres has not been correctly completed. A test will not be incorrect if the driver realizes his/her mistake, goes back to the point which the mistake occurred and then completes the test correctly as required by the diagram".
D.34 Two competitors may share the same vehicle but no one can drive more than one vehicle.
D.41 Vehicles need not be taxed or registered as the whole event takes place on private land.(except Class E and Production Car Competitors)
21. All marshals are Judges of Fact and their decision will be final, a list will be available at signing on.
22. Please make sure that your car is properly silenced to comply with C(b)23
23. Catering and Toilet Facilities are available throughout the day in the main services
